

AGREEMENT FOR CARE

Dillingham Department of Public Safety Animal Foster Care Program

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this _____ day of _____, 2007, by and between _____ (Foster Caregiver) and the **CITY OF DILLINGHAM** (City). For good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Foster Caregiver and City agree to the Foster Care of an animal described as: _____ as follows:

1. **Term** - This Agreement shall be for thirty (30) days, from _____ 2007, through and including _____ 2007, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.

2. **Foster Caregiver Responsibilities** - Foster Caregiver shall perform/provide the following services in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement:

- a. Provide indoor/outdoor kennel boarding for the animals impounded by City;
- b. Provide a safe, clean, area for animals;
- c. Provide wholesome food and clean water;
- d. Provide access to veterinary care in the event of illness or injury to animal;
- e. Provide proof of current City of Dillingham and State of Alaska business licenses.

3. **City Responsibilities** - City agrees to provide a one (1) time payment of \$ _____ to the Foster Caregiver upon completion of this Agreement.

4. **Conditions**

- a. The City, or its agent(s), have final authority over which animals are placed in the Animal Foster Care Program;
- b. The animal sheltered by the Foster Caregiver remains the property of the City until such time as it is adopted and all fees for adoption and licensing are paid, or the animal is returned to the City;
- c. If after the period of this contract the Foster Caregiver cannot adopt said animal the Foster Caregiver will surrender the animal, and release all rights and claims resulting from the keeping of the animal, to the City, or its designated agent(s);
- d. The Foster Caregiver shall hold the City, and its agent(s) harmless for damage or injury caused by, or related to, the keeping of the animal of their choosing while it is in their care;
- e. If the Foster Caregiver adopts the animal out to themselves or a third party all adoptions fees, in addition to the payment specified in this Agreement, may be retained by the Foster Caregiver upon proof of payment of City licensing fee by the adopting party;
- f. In the event that the animal becomes ill or is injured due to neglect, mistreatment, or negligence while in the care of the Foster Caregiver, the Foster Caregiver shall provide for the costs of veterinary care to said animal.
- g. No more that four (4) animals may be retained by any Foster Caregiver at any one time.
- h. Either party may dissolve this Agreement upon forty-eight (48) hours notice. Agreements dissolved at a time less than seventy-five (75) percent of completion of term of this Agreement will result in non-payment of any payments specified above.
